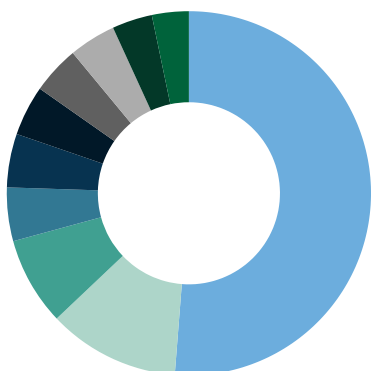

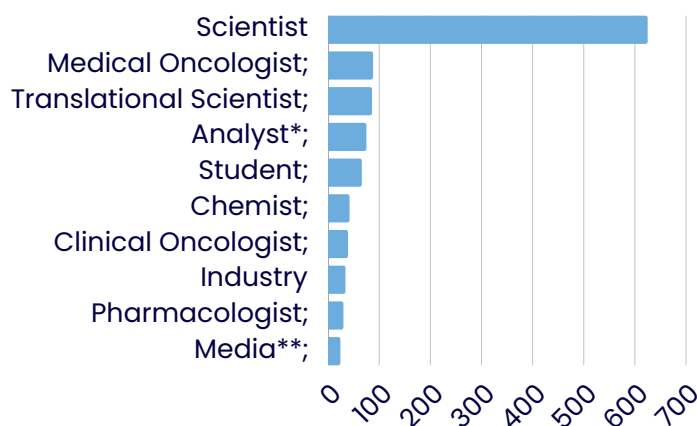

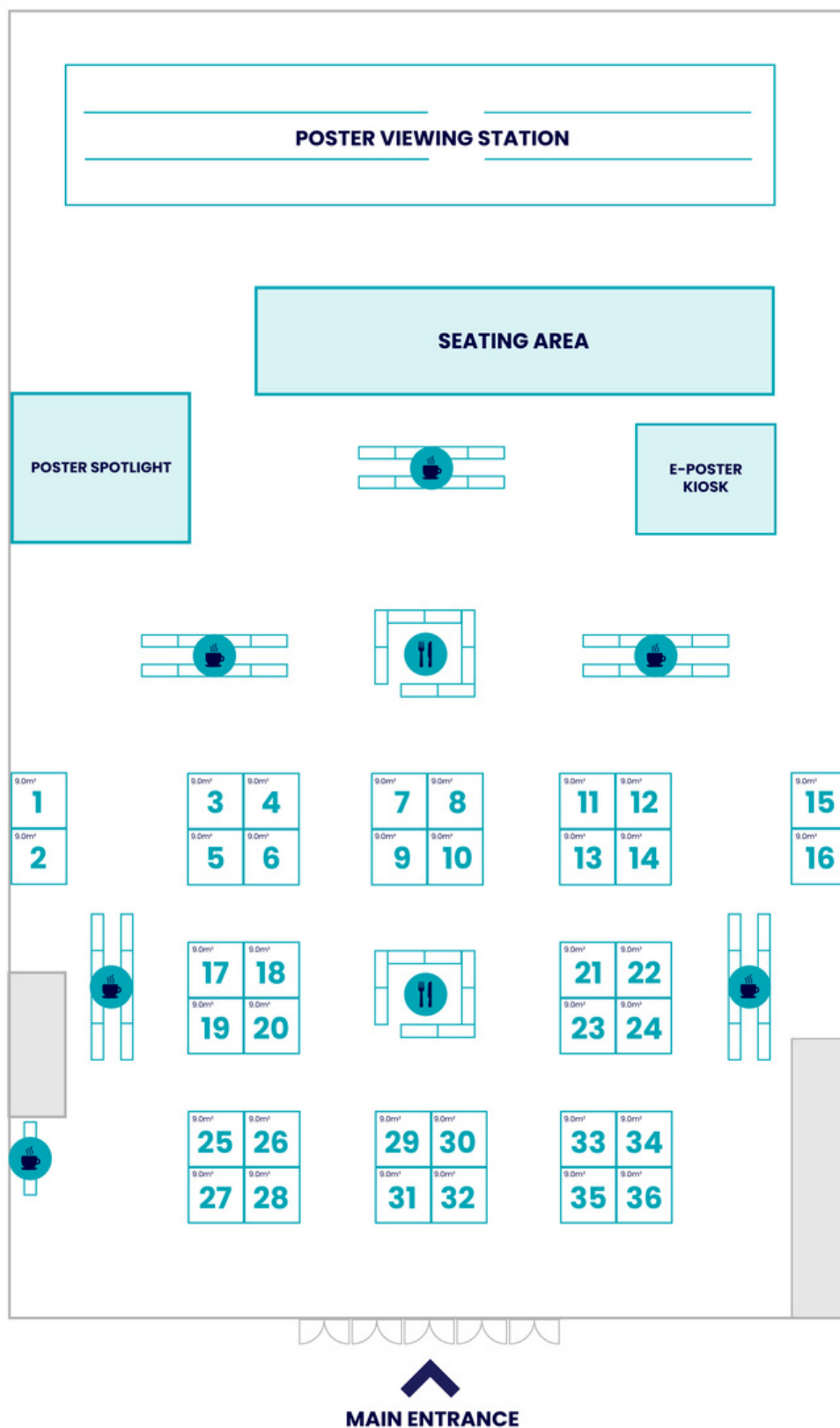


Exhibition opportunities

- The minimum exhibition space is 9 sqm. Multiples of 9 sqm may be purchased to have a bigger booth.
- Space allocation will be made on a 'first come, first served' basis. A completed order form should be emailed to ENA@eortc.org to ensure reservation of a desired location.
- Booth package/space can be ordered until eight weeks before the symposium starts.
- The exhibition layout may change if a redesign is necessary due to organisational changes and/or to optimise the space, which might also change the booth numbers.
- Note that due to the strict European GDPR regulations we cannot provide any delegate lists. However, you may order a badge scanner to collect data of the delegates visiting your booth.

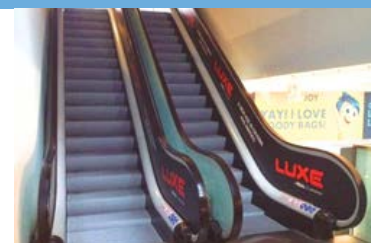

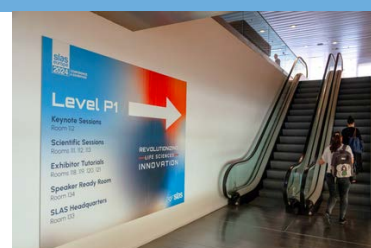

YOUNG SCIENTIST GRANTS

**€ 8 000 for
5 grants**

Travel grants will be made available to young scientists to facilitate their attendance at the ENA 2026 Symposium.

Young scientists will be able to apply for a maximum of 1 000 Euros, which will cover their travel during the event. To be eligible for the travel grant, an applicant must meet the following criteria:

- Applicants must be a MPhil/ PhD student or 1st year postdoctoral scientist.
- Applicants must submit an abstract as first author to the ENA 2026 Symposium and must have primarily conducted the research presented in the abstract. Candidates must apply for the grant at the time of abstract submission. Application is made via the online application form and only applicants with an accepted abstract will be considered.
- Candidates can be from any country and any profession. They must register for the ENA 2026 Symposium and must present their abstract at the meeting. The cost includes the administration fee.

RESIDENT IN TRAINING GRANTS

**€ 8 000 for
5 grants**

Travel grants will be made available to young residents in training to facilitate their attendance at the ENA 2026 Symposium.

Residents in training will be able to apply for a maximum of 1 000 Euros, which will cover their travel during the Symposium. To be eligible for the travel grant, an applicant must meet the following criteria:

- Applicants must be in training or out of training for no more than five years. Candidates who have had career disruptions are eligible, provided they are no more than 5 years full-time equivalent out of training. Training is defined as any clinical or post-graduate training.
- Applicants must submit an abstract as first author to the ENA 2026 Symposium and must have primarily conducted the research presented in the abstract. Candidates must apply for the grant at the time of abstract submission. Application is made via the online application form and only applicants with an accepted abstract will be considered.



Meeting rooms

The ENA Symposium provides sponsors and exhibitors the opportunity to book onsite meeting space for internal meetings, offering a private environment for company stakeholders.
